

# Persevering over poverty

Addressing food insecurity in Tioga County isn't just a matter of charity. It's a fundamental obligation to ensure the well-being of everyone in our community.

I speak from personal experience, having grown up in a single-parent household where financial struggles were a daily reality. While we never went hungry, the meager assistance from SNAP benefits often left us scraping by, unable to afford basic necessities such as butter, eggs or milk.

My mother's disability meant she couldn't work, and the Social Security payments she received barely covered essential expenses such as rent and utilities. Unable to find stable housing, we moved frequently. In times of desperation, we turned to local churches for help, as there was no organization like Tioga County Rural Ministry in Chenango County.

Despite these challenges, I persevered, eventually finding my way to college. Today, I stand as a testament to the resilience that can be born of adversity. My journey from hardship to stability has imbued me with a deep sense of purpose, driving me to make a meaningful difference in the lives of others.

As the Outreach Services
Coordinator at TCRM, I am
committed to leveraging my
experiences to support families
facing similar circumstances. At
TCRM, our goal is to empower people
to transcend the limitations imposed
by poverty and reach their full
potential.


The graph below, disappointingly, points to the stark reality that continues to haunt not only Tioga County, but our friends and neighbors across our state and country.

Looking at all of the Food Bank of the Southern Tier programs and agencies in Tioga County, the number of individual requests for Q1 2024 (January – March) is up 21 % compared to 2023 and up 59 percent compared to 2019.

Years ago, we would have thought that \$15 an hour, the current per-hour pay in New York state for workers at McDonald's, was a more than decent wage. Perhaps the only silver lining to the aftermath of COVID was that it helped to increase hourly pay levels. Still, the reality that we daily see from people who come to us seeking assistance is that we are far from offering a basic living wage.

Our neighbors in Pennsylvania provide a \$7.25 minimum wage. That low base pay affects all, too, who work in higher-echelon jobs. For example, a recent Tioga County pantry visitor, a full-time employed RN working in Pennsylvania, mentioned that she had eagerly been awaiting the merger of Guthrie and Lourdes so she could apply for a \$50-an-hour position. But here in New York state, while our minimum wage has increased, the following are some of the disturbing statistics we are seeing in the lives of those who come to us seeking financial assistance.

Upon seeing these monthly statistics, one of our Board members asked if there was a common denominator to the huge increase we are seeing in new and full-time employed people asking for help. Galen Morehead, TCRM's Outreach Services Coordinator, after viewing his financial aid request paperwork, noted that, across the board, the results showed low wages.

While this issue is far more complex than a brief article can expose, I mention these statistics to highlight the need but also to give great thanks to our volunteers and donors who support our ministry, enabling TCRM to be a haven of hope for many.

I am daily humbled by my co-workers and volunteers who reach out with care and compassion to those who walk through our doors. I am awed by the diverse ways in which we offer hope to those affected by one emergency, one car repair, one medical surgery, one victim of a scam, one surprisingly high energy bill. Two weeks ago we helped a single dad with two young children, freshly out of prison after a 1½ year stay, obtain an "out of the box" request for an e-bike, critical for helping him find meaningful employment. He was living in a rural area and unable to drive because of previous alcohol abuse. We were able to provide a hand up to start him on a new path.

Such stories are too numerous to mention. How can we do this? You who offer time, talent and treasure are the lynchpin to our success stories. Thank you immensely for supporting TCRM and the ministry we provide to our neighbors across Tioga. As we look forward in July to celebrating our 46<sup>th</sup> anniversary, we count on your continued support. You have a daily place in my heart and in my prayer.
